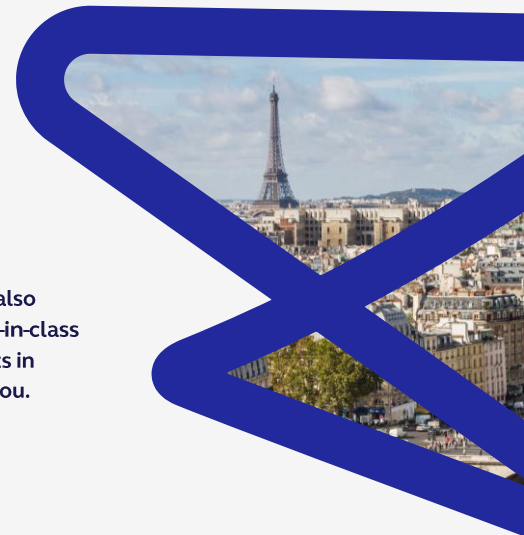

Be at the heart of the match

Rugby World Cup 2023 will take place in France from 8 September - 28 October with matches played in nine venues across 10 host cities. The tournament will be the 10th men's Rugby World Cup and the second to be hosted by France after a memorable event in 2007.

RWC 2023 will set new standards in social responsibility, inclusivity and sustainability for a major rugby event, targeting four key pillars for the tournament's legacy: acting for sustainability and circular economy, supporting education and employment, respecting and protecting the environment, and promoting inclusivity.

Rugby World Cup is the world championship for the sport of rugby union and takes place every four years. Twenty teams will take part in Rugby World Cup 2023, divided into four pools of five teams, followed by QFs, SFs, a bronze medal playoff and the finals. Twelve teams qualified directly by finishing in the top three in their pool at Japan 2019 and eight from a global qualification process – with 48 matches played across 51 days.

World Rugby have ensured an even more keenly contested tournament in the group stages, extending the competition by one week to ensure that all teams have a minimum five days between each fixture. This expanded schedule means Rugby World Cup 2023 has a unique 'weekend' feel to it which is ideally suited to Official Hospitality engagement: 42 of the tournament's 48 matches will take place on either a Friday, Saturday or Sunday.

TEAMS 1/3



Argentina

Having beaten New Zealand in 2020 and drawn twice with Australia, Argentina will be among the most fancied of the major teams. Their fixtures against England and Japan promise to be spectacular.



Australia

Australia's open style of play have made them synonymous with some of the most memorable moments in Rugby World Cup history. Two-time winners of the Webb Ellis Cup, in 1991 and 1999, Australia will hope to dominate once more in 2023.



Chile

Qualifying for their first ever Rugby World Cup after a nail biting victory against USA, the Chilean team have already made sporting history. Now, they will be looking to pull together their best performances against their Pool D opponents



England

England remain the only northern hemisphere nation to lift the Webb Ellis Cup but struggled to hit peak form in recent Six Nations. But, with this generation of brilliant players, beware the wounded Lion.



Fiji

The Pacific Island nation's spectacular game, a clever mix of power, speed, and skill and agility with the ball in hand, is a pleasure to watch. The Fijians find themselves drawn against Australia and Wales for the third time in a row.



Georgia

Considered to be one of the world's fastest-growing rugby nations and one of the world's most-improved sides, Georgia have competed in the last 5 Rugby World Cups through qualification. Can they better their previous performances?



Ireland

As one of the Six Nations powerhouses, Ireland will be thrilled at the prospect of a European-hosted Rugby World Cup and the chance to achieve a major milestone: to get beyond the quarter-finals of the tournament for the first time in history.



Italy

Finishing third in their pool in the last five editions, Italy will be targeting getting through the knockout stages for the first time. But to do that they will have to overcome either New Zealand or France, two RWC 2023 favourites.

TEAMS 2/3



Japan

The surprise team in the last two tournaments, Japan captivated both local and overseas fans with their fast-paced, attacking game. With a new professional league recently launched, Japan look good to repeat their sensational performances in 2023.



Namibia

Having qualified for the event in 1999, Namibia have been part of every tournament since. Unable to win a pool match in their RWC career so far they will be looking to make history in France.



New Zealand

New Zealand are three-time winners of the Webb Ellis Cup and, stung by their semifinal exit in 2019, will once again be among the favourites at Rugby World Cup 2023. The most dominant team in the history of world rugby.



Romania

Romania will return to the games biggest stage and take their place in Pool B alongside Webb Ellis Cup holders South Africa, Ireland, Scotland and an additional qualifier, as they feature in their 10th Rugby World Cup in 2023.



Samoa

Samoa has been responsible for more upsets in Rugby World Cup history than any other team and the proud Pacific Islanders will be looking to continue that giant-killing reputation.



Scotland

There's no shortage of self-belief in this team, backed up by several strong performances to match. Playing a fluid and fast pace of rugby, on their day they have the potential to rattle the top tier teams and cause some major upsets.



South Africa

Defending champions South Africa will have the opportunity to write another chapter in their inspiring history by becoming the first team to win the Webb Ellis Cup four times.

Tonga

After a dramatic qualification journey beating Hong Kong at the final hurdle, Tonga have secured their place in another RWC. Now they will be looking to build on their previous record of 2 Pool Stage victories in 2007 & 2011.



Wales

With both ups & downs in recent Six Nations, Wales will be pushing to build on the record of three-time semi-finalists (1987, 2011, 2019) at Rugby World Cup 2023.



Uruguay

Uruguay is cementing their reputation in world rugby with a stunning performance that saw them beat the USA and qualify for the third consecutive RWC. Although being drawn with France and New Zealand, Uruguay will be looking to build on their achievements from Japan 2019.

Lyon **OL Stadium**

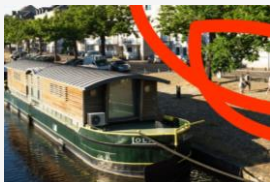
After the success of RWC 2007 and the 2016 European Challenge Cup final, Lyon is preparing to dazzle with yet another five-star event in France's third largest stadium.

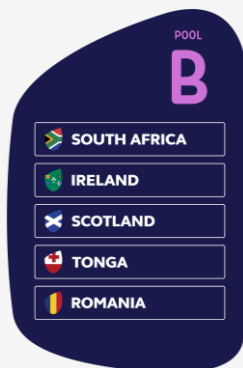
